

PROPOSED SCHOOL FEEDER SYSTEMS ASSOCIATED WITH OPTIONS A AND B

INTRODUCTION

The following two tables have been prepared to support the elementary, middle and high school Options Maps A and B by listing the proposed school feeder networks that are illustrated on each map. Each matrix is organized by the high schools into which all middle and elementary schools feed. The left-hand column lists all elementary school attendance zones, including schools slated for consolidation/closure, schools proposed for combination into primary grade centers and a proposed new school. The second column describes the recommended action for each elementary school, followed by the middle school to which each elementary attendance zone is assigned and then the high school. Elementary schools which currently feed the two middle schools that are proposed to close (Kennedy and Parks) are reassigned to other nearby middle schools as identified in each table.

It should be understood that each table describes the respective Options **as fully implemented** or in other words, **AFTER** all proposed closures, school additions and proposed new school buildings are completed. In such cases, it is assumed that resulting changes to feeder patterns would **not** occur **until** the additional capacity is brought on line. For example, the proposed new "North Side Middle School" shown under Option A, is not scheduled to open until 2017 or 2018. Therefore, the elementary schools shown to feed into that new school (Centennial, E. Rivers and a new ES to be located to the East of I-75) would continue to feed the "North Atlanta Middle School" (the former NAHS site) until this new middle school is built. Notes accompanying each table also describe how the CSK/BEST single gender academies are fed.
